

Gospel:





At Easter, we celebrate that our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, conquered death, rose from the dead, and remains very much alive. To the world of non-believers: what!? It is quite a big reality to swallow. But for the believer, it is a reality that inspires us to the point where we find ourselves constantly sharing the Gospel with everyone we meet! Right? So what does Easter mean to you? The question is not what do you believe. The question is what impact does Easter have on you? How do your actions demonstrate the power of Easter? What does it mean we you hear that we, the Church, are an Easter people?

You may be saying right now that you have no intention of becoming an evangelist, passing out Bibles to all you meet. But I would like to suggest that you actually have a more powerful way of evangelizing others: everyday stewardship. Actions speak louder than words and the way you live your life can be a great testimony to all those you encounter. By acknowledging the gifts you have been given, cultivating those so they grow to an increase, and then sharing them fully with God and with others in God's name will give testimony to your belief that Jesus is alive and seeking a relationship with each of his people. If more of us won't live our lives in this manner, then nonbelievers and non-intentional disciples will ask the question, "What difference does Easter make anyway?" Jesus died and rose for you and me. To be sure, it DOES make a difference.

La corresponsabilidad diaria

Durante la Pascua celebramos el hecho de que Jesús venció la muerte, resucitó de entre los muertos y sigue vivo entre nosotros. Al no creyente esto es difícil de entender. Es una realidad enorme. Pero para el creyente, es una realidad que nos inspira y que nos ayuda a compartir el Evangelio con todos. ¿Qué significa la Pasca para usted? Note que la pregunta no es si usted cree, sino que ¿qué efecto tiene la Pascua para usted? ¿Cómo demuestran sus acciones el poder de la Pascua? ¿Qué significa el decir que la Iglesia somos una gente pascual?

Puede estar decidido que no quiere ser evangelizador dándoles Biblias a todos que se encuentra. Pero le quiero sugerir que usted tiene una manera más fuerte de evangelizar: la corresponsabilidad diaria. Jesús murió y resucitó para usted y para mí. Asegúrese de que sí haga una diferencia.


