

Archdiocese of Miami Safe Environment This is a five-part series for April Child Abuse Prevention Month



The Local Coordinator at ADOM entities oversee compliance of the Safe Environment Policy and also serve as the liaison between their site and the archdiocesan administrative offices working to provide reports and information as requested by independent auditors. This is accomplished through continuous communication with the Safe Environment Offices to check status of background checks, Virtus accounts, and the latest processes for running reports and numbers. If a policy changes or a process is updated they in turn need to guide, navigate, and accelerate those changes on site. Especially when talking about internet safety, it is imperative we utilize the most current tools, resources, and techniques at our fingertips—literally. Last year's audit report indicates over 8,000 employees, nearly 2,500 educators, 324 priests, 122 deacons, 53 candidates for ordination, and over 51,000 volunteers received the adults Virtus training. Also over 43,000 children received the Virtus Teaching Boundary Safety lessons. For both the adult and the children's training every click and response is documented. Esta es una serie de cinco partes para abril, Mes de la Prevención del Abuso Infantil. Los coordinadores locales en las instituciones arquidiocesanas supervisan el cumplimiento de la Política de Ambiente Seguro y también sirven de enlace entre sus sedes y las oficinas administrativas de la Arquidiócesis, y trabajan para brindar reportes e información según lo soliciten los auditores independientes. Esto se logra a través de la comunicación continua con las Oficinas de Ambiente Seguro para comprobar el estado de las verificaciones de antecedentes, las cuentas de Virtus, y los últimos procedimientos para generar informes y cifras. Si una política cambia o un procedimiento se actualiza, ellos necesitan manejar, dirigir y acelerar esos cambios en sus sedes. Cuando hablamos, especialmente, sobre la seguridad en la internet, es imprescindible que utilicemos las herramientas, los recursos y las técnicas más actuales que están a nuestro alcance. El informe de auditoría del año pasado indica que más de 8,000 empleados, casi 2,500 educadores, 324 sacerdotes, 122 diáconos, 53 candidatos a la ordenación y más de 51,000 voluntarios recibieron la capacitación de Virtus para adultos. Asimismo, más de 43,000 niños recibieron las lecciones de la de niños. 


**Spotlight on a Legacy Family

Gospel Meditation

I always feel a little sad when someone begins to speak to me with the words, "Father, I know you're so busy, but ..." It happens a lot. And I get it. He or she is trying to be respectful of my time. But it saddens me because a priest makes Jesus present to people in a special way, and Jesus always has time for us. Don't we all feel at times that God just doesn't have time for us? Nonsense. Just look at the stunning "Road to Emmaus" story we hear this week. It's the day Jesus rose from the dead. And the Risen One appears in disguise to two disciples. He walks with them, chats with them, and eventually eats with them. It could have been hours he spends with them – two unnamed persons – in the middle of nowhere. On the day he rose from the dead! My friends, please take this to heart: The Risen Jesus is not too busy to spend time with you! He doesn't have "better things to do." You and I are members of this crucified and risen Body. He therefore has all the time in the world to be with us. So, I challenge you this week to approach him confidently in prayer and conversation.
