



Dear Parishioners of St. Rose of Lima.

Since the beginning of our parish, we have been blessed with the privilege and necessary resources to offer multiple Masses on Sundays and weekdays at a range of different times. Like me, I'm sure you have noticed that some of our Masses are more well-attended than others and that some of our Masses have very low attendance.

One of my obligations as your Pastor, is to be an observant and faithful steward of the resources of our parish so that the parish itself can be sustainable into the future, both in terms of financial resources and in terms of caring for each other, priests, and parishioner alike.

Therefore, I am announcing changes to our weekly Mass schedules in order to best preserve and optimize both our human and financial resources. These Mass schedule changes are listed below. The decision to make these changes came after a lengthy period of observation, prayer, conversation, and with the full support of the Pastoral Council whose role it is to advise the Pastor on matters critical to the parish as a whole.

I recognize that for some of you these changes may be difficult. This will be a time to help one another to adjust and adapt to the new Mass schedules and to continue to build a caring community centered in Christ and the Eucharist.

We are fortunate here at St. Rose of Lima that we have always had daily, weekend, and Sunday Masses. Very few parishes have had two daily Masses and our census does not support that at this time. I invite each of you to take an active role in continuing to build the people of God at St. Rose of Lima Parish by inviting and encouraging new members to join and members who haven't been here for some time to return. We welcome all God's people here at St. Rose.

Beginning July 1, 2023, our new mass schedule will be as follows: Saturday: 8:15 AM, 5 PM Vigil Mass Sunday: 8 AM, 10 AM, 12 PM (Spanish), 5 PM Weekday masses: 8:15 AM

Tuesday: 7 PM (Spanish)

Confession: Saturday 4:00 - 4:50 PM, Sunday 11:15 - 11:45 AM




