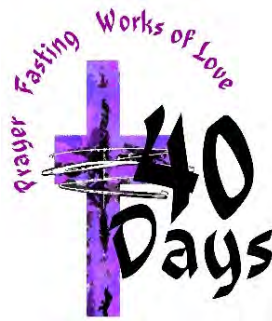
## **TENEBRAE SERVICE AND PRAYER OF THE CROSS**

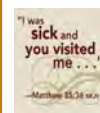

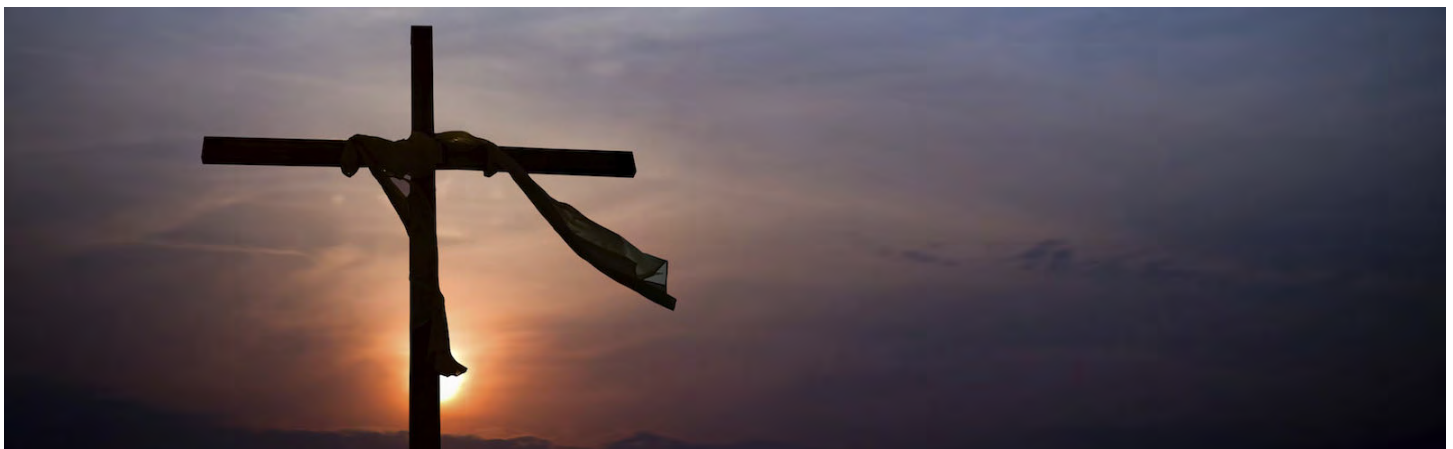
