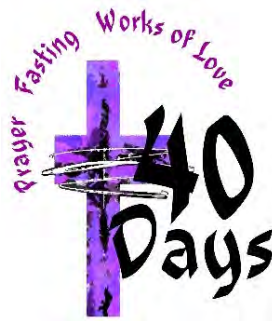
TENEBRAE SERVICE AND PRAYER OF THE CROSS

Friday, March 23 at 7:30 PM (church)

All are invited to participate in a reflective meditation upon the Passion and Death of Jesus based on Hebrew and Christian Scripture readings. This ancient Liturgy of the Word is called *Tenebrae*, a Latin word meaning *Shadows*. The shadows are symbolized by a candle ritual during the prayer. This evening will also include quiet time of prayer before the Sacred Cross.

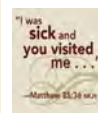

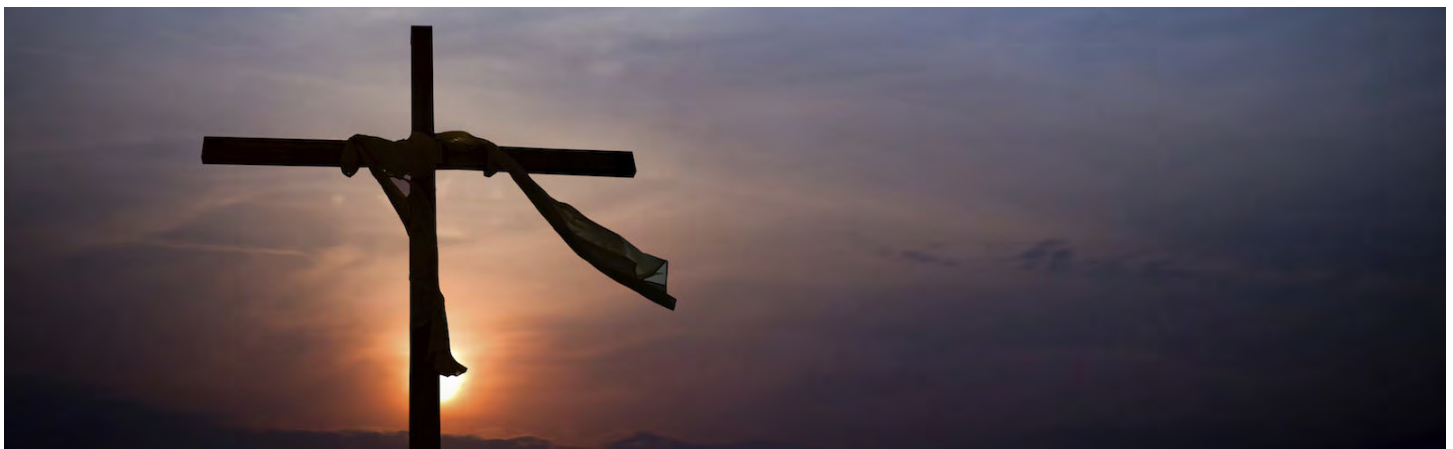
