



# Please welcome Fr. Luis Perez, Parochial Vicar

Blessed day!

Archbishop Wenski assigned me to St. Rose of Lima Parish this week and I am grateful. I was baptized Luis Alberto in Santa Clara, Cuba in 1959, one year after birth. I grew up with my mother who emigrated to the United States in 1970, thanks be to God! After three days in Miami, we were sent to Bridgeport, Connecticut where I attended middle school at Our Lady of the Rosary Parochial School. I delivered the Bridgeport Post newspaper after school and got a taste of work and money. After three and a half years, my mother decided to move to Miami. During High School and while attending Miami Dade College, I continued working in different areas. After a three year discernment process, I was accepted at St. John Vianney College Seminary in 1987 by the Grace of God. In 1991, the formation process continued at St. Vincent de Paul Seminary in Boynton Beach until my ordination in 1995. After ordination, I was invited to serve at Guantanamo Bay ministering to the Cuban refugees there and assisting the Sisters in celebrating the sacraments for two weeks. I was then assigned to Holy Family Parish in North Miami until December 1997. My adventure continued at San Isidro Mission Church until December, 2000 when I was sent to Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Church and School where I served as Pastor until after the merger with St. Richard's Parish in 2012. After a year at St. Maximilian Kolbe, I received an invitation from Bishop Emilio Aranguren who taught me in CCD as a child, to serve in Cuba as a missionary for two years. With Archbishop Wenski's support, I spent those vocational fruitful years in the dioceses of Holguin and Santa Clara. Upon my return in 2015, I had the opportunity to serve as Chaplain with Catholic Health Services in Lauderdale Lakes while in residence at St. Helen's parish. In June of 2018 after missing parish life, Archbishop assigned me to San Pablo Church in Marathon, Florida Keys where I served three years. In order to be closer to my 87 year old mother who dedicated her life to me, I was assigned to San Lazaro Parish where I was a homegrown back in 1983. Experiencing a need to return to my pastoral beginnings without the administrative responsibilities of a parish, I am excited to now be at St. Rose to serve as associate pastor to Fr. George. I am very happy to be at St. Rose of Lima and to be joining the community in the celebration of the 75th anniversary of the parish. May the Grace of God continue to guide every step of our journey together as we strive to extend the Kingdom of God on this earth!


