



Each year, Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is a 40-day season (not counting Sundays) marked by repentance, fasting, reflection, and ultimately celebration. The 40-day period represents Christ's time of temptation in the wilderness, where he fasted and where Satan tempted him. Lent asks Catholics to set aside a time each year for similar fasting, marking an intentional season of focus on Christ's life, ministry, sacrifice, and resurrection.

**REGULATIONS ON FASTING AND ABSTINENCE**

**Ash Wednesday, March 5, and Good Friday, April 18, are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat.**

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 years and 59 years (inclusive). On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday are all days of abstinence.

Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition. Fasting, almsgiving and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

Cada año, el Miércoles de Ceniza marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma. La Cuaresma es una temporada de 40 días (sin contar los domingos) marcada por el arrepentimiento, el ayuno, la reflexión y, en última instancia, la celebración. El período de 40 días representa el tiempo de tentación de Cristo en el desierto, donde ayunó y donde Satanás lo tentó. La Cuaresma pide a los católicos que reserven un tiempo cada año para un ayuno similar, marcando una temporada intencional de enfoque en la vida, el ministerio, el sacrificio y la resurrección de Cristo.

**REGULACIONES SOBRE EL AYUNO Y LA ABSTINENCIA**  
**El Miércoles de Ceniza, 5 de marzo, y el Viernes Santo, 18 de abril, son días de ayuno y abstinencia. Todos los viernes de Cuaresma son también días de abstinencia de carne.**

El ayuno debe ser observado el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo por todos los católicos entre las edades de 18 años y 59 años (inclusive). En un día de ayuno se permite una comida completa. Se pueden tomar dos comidas más pequeñas, suficientes para mantener las fuerzas, de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno, pero juntas no deben equivaler a otra comida completa. No está permitido comer entre comidas, Pero los líquidos están permitidos. La abstinencia de carne debe ser observada por todos los católicos mayores de 14 años. El Miércoles de Ceniza, todos los viernes de Cuaresma y el Viernes Santo son días de abstinencia.

Nota: Si una persona no puede observar las regulaciones anteriores debido a una mala salud u otras razones graves, se le insta a practicar otras formas de abnegación que sean adecuadas a su condición. El ayuno, la limosna y la oración son las tres disciplinas tradicionales de la Cuaresma. Los fieles y los catecúmenos deben emprender seriamente estas prácticas, con espíritu de penitencia y de preparación para el bautismo o de renovación del bautismo en la Pascua.


