

The Good Samaritan didn't just feel sorry for the wounded traveler, he took action. Today, Jesus calls each of us to take action through our stewardship. Your gifts transform Christ's words into concrete acts of love, healing, and hope.

"Jesus said to him, 'Go and do likewise.'" (Luke 10:37)

It is easier to take your eyes off the spiritual to concentrate on the temporal. We tend to look away from heavenly things and direct our attentions to earthly pursuits. We concentrate on the accumulation of things that will soon pass away in this world instead of living a life pleasing to God and hoping of rewards laid up in heaven. Jesus made it clear that His kingdom was not of this world. He shows us that our true joy comes from our "invisible" gifts like love, mercy and forgiveness. True joy comes from living a grateful and generous lifestyle; become more "God-centered" and less "self-centered."

BENEATH THE SURFACE

Mini reflection:

As Christians we know that everyone is our neighbor. It's drilled into us from the first time we hear this reading. But do we approach the victims that we see? Or do we draw away from the suffering of others in fear and confusion, thinking: "That's not my problem"?

Crossing the Street

It takes a cold, hard, godless heart to step over a wounded man on the street. But in the parable of the Good Samaritan, the priest and the Levite didn't step over the half-dead traveler. I think we picture them doing so, in our collective imagining of this well-known story, but the words of the Gospel are quite clear. "When he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side," Jesus says of both. So they saw him. They saw his need. It made them uncomfortable; it confused them — many scholars have said that Judaic law concerning the touching of dead bodies might have made them reluctant to approach — and so they decided the simplest way to file this situation in the Not My Problem category was to cross the street.

But that still leaves a half-dead guy on the road. And we all, 2,000 years later, still think of the priest and the Levite as cold and hard and godless — even if they didn't *want* to be, even if they didn't think of themselves that way — because the bottom line is, they didn't see the half-dead guy as their problem.


As Christians we know that everyone is our neighbor. It's drilled into us from the first time we hear this reading.

Well, I don't know about you, but I find myself crossing the street a lot more than I should.

There is so much pain and suffering in the world. We certainly can't begin to alleviate it all. But we have to start with the pain and the suffering that we see, that's right in front of us — even if it's something we really, really want to ignore. Even if we find it inconvenient or confusing or scary or weird.

The heroism of the Good Samaritan wasn't in his selfless actions, although those were certainly commendable. It was in his courage. "He approached the victim," Jesus said.

Can we approach the victims we see?
Do we have that courage?

RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

Mini Reflexión:

Como cristianos sabemos que todos son nuestro prójimo. Se nos inculca desde la primera vez que escuchamos esta lectura. Pero ¿nos acercamos a las víctimas que vemos? ¿O nos alejamos del sufrimiento de los demás con miedo y confusión, pensando: "Ese no es mi problema"?

Cruzando la Calle

Se necesita un corazón frío, duro e impío para pasar por encima de un hombre herido en la calle. Pero en la parábola del Buen Samaritano, el sacerdote y el levita no pasaron por encima del viajero medio muerto. Creo que nos los imaginamos haciéndolo, en nuestra imaginación colectiva de esta historia tan conocida, pero las palabras del Evangelio son bastante claras. "Cuando lo vio, pasó por el lado opuesto", dice Jesús de ambos. Así que lo vieron. Vieron su necesidad. Los incomodó; los confundió — muchos eruditos han dicho que la ley judaica con respecto a tocar cadáveres podría haberlos hecho reacios a acercarse— por lo que decidieron que la forma más sencilla de registrar esta situación de la categoría "No es mi problema" era cruzar la calle. Pero eso todavía deja a un tipo medio muerto en el camino. Y todos nosotros, 2,000 años después, seguimos pensando en el sacerdote y el levita como fríos, duros e impíos, incluso si *no querían* serlo, incluso si no se consideraban a sí mismos de esa manera, porque la conclusión es que no veían al tipo medio muerto como su problema. Como cristianos sabemos que todos son nuestro prójimo. Se nos inculca desde la primera vez que escuchamos esta lectura. Bueno, no sé tú, pero yo me encuentro cruzando la calle mucho más de lo que debería. Hay tanto dolor y sufrimiento en el mundo. Ciertamente, no podemos empezar a aliviarlo todo. Pero tenemos que empezar con el dolor y el sufrimiento que vemos, que está justo frente a nosotros, incluso si es algo que realmente queremos ignorar. Incluso si lo encontramos inconveniente o confuso o aterrador o raro. El heroísmo del Buen Samaritano no estaba en sus acciones desinteresadas, aunque ciertamente eran comedades. Estaba en su valentía. "Se acercó a la víctima", dijo Jesús.


